City of St. Helens - Former Boise Veneer Plant Property Assessment The 22-acre Veneer Mill site located at 400 S. First Street, St. Helens, Oregon was acquired by Boise, Inc., in the 1970's and operated as a veneer mill until 2008 when it was closed and 36 jobs were lost. Since 2008, Boise has undertaken demolition of the buildings as preparation for sale of the property. The City of St. Helens is actively seeking to acquire the Property and applied for funding assistance to complete a Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) to ASTM Standards as well as Phase Two ESA additional soil and groundwater sampling necessary to identify cleanup options for the property and to provide the City sufficient information to negotiate a Prospective Purchaser Agreement with DEQ.	60,000

Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board - OWEB		
Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Scappoose Bay, Lower Columbia River, and Upper Nehalem Watershed Councils to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	163,678	
Monitoring Funds provided effectiveness monitoring to evaluate restoration projects occurring at the confluence of North and South Scappoose Creeks.	2,400	
Outreach and Education Funding to support the Watershed Stewardship Project for local schools in Columbia County and provide hands-on wetland restoration experience for students in the St. Helen's School District. These programs provide classroom lessons, field experience, and service opportunities to engage students and community members in activities that increase understanding and appreciation of their local watershed.	46,468	
Restoration Eleven grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include improving water quality and quantity, removing invasive plants, rehabilitating riparian areas, and improving instream habitat and fish passage. For example, two culverts on the Clatskanie River that created a total fish barrier were replaced, providing fish with access to five miles of upstream habitat.	734,318
