Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Coos and Coquille Watershed Associations and the Tenmile Lakes Basin Partnership to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	171,432	
Monitoring Funds provided effectiveness monitoring to evaluate restoration projects along the West Fork Millicoma River and gather stream gage and weather station data for future monitoring and assessment needs in the Coos watershed.	80,529	
Outreach and Education Funding provided local students outdoor field experience in water conservation science. This program provided hands-on science activities teaching students about watershed processes, monitoring, and conservation.	44,782	
Restoration Thirty-nine grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include creating irrigation efficiencies and improving water quality, removing noxious and invasive plants, rehabilitating riparian areas, and improving instream habitat and fish passage. For example, a project in the North Slough replaced a tidegate with a more fish-friendly structure and improved road conditions and road drainage patterns upstream, improving fish access and reducing sediment entering into streams.	2,256,897	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical design and assessment assistance for landowner projects in the South and Catching Sloughs, and along the East Fork Millicoma River.	63,520
