Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	142,750	
Outreach and Education Funding provided local K-12 students to participate in watershed-based classroom lessons in combination with outdoor field activities intended to increase understanding and appreciation of their local watershed.	35,409	
Restoration Fifteen grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include creating irrigation efficiencies, improving water quality, removing invasive weeds, rehabilitating riparian areas, developing off-stream watering sites, and improving instream habitat and fish passage. For example, several projects created offsite watering sites and installed livestock exclusion fencing in riparian zones to improve water quality in streams that provide spawning and rearing habitat for salmon and steelhead.	160,510
