<p>City of Condon - Former Reser Property Assessment Project In May 2011, the City of Condon acquired a former service station/automotive repair and painting shop property located along its historic main street with the intent of cleaning up a blighted site and clearing the property of all encumbrances for either sale or development. The City applied for funding assistance to complete an Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) as preparation for application to OBDD for cleanup financing through OBDD's federally funded Oregon Coalition Brownfields Cleanup Fund. The ABCA will evaluate various alternatives to remediate the contamination and select a preferred alternative most suitable for future reuse of the site within its zoning parameters.</p>	5,000	
<p>Port of Arlington Environmental Sentry Corporation - Former Condon Radar Base Assessment Project The Port of Arlington Environment Sentry Corporation (PAESC), a 501(c)3 non-profit organization is seeking to acquire 58.29 acres of the former Condon Radar Station property located in Gilliam County. PAESC applied for funding assistance to complete the Phase One Environmental Site Assessment (ESA), an Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) and the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) as part of its environmental due diligence and in preparation for cleanup of the site. The property is zoned general industrial and represents the largest piece of industrial property in or near the town of Condon. The only other large parcel of industrial property in the County is 40 miles north near the town of Arlington. PAESC plans to redevelop the site as an industrial business park.</p>	45,625

Restoration Twenty-three grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include installing riparian exclusion fencing, improving grazing management, managing western juniper, removing noxious and invasive plants, developing off-stream watering sites, and improving instream habitat and fish passage. For example, over 80 miles of exclusion fencing will be installed, protecting 3 important steelhead-bearing streams from unrestricted livestock access.	429,942
