<b>Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board - OWEB</b>		
Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds were provided to the Harney County Watershed Council to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	241,820	
Monitoring Funds were provided to monitor and assess the effects of a number of individual carp-control projects to identify measures that can be taken on a larger scale to reduce the invasive carp population in the Harney and Malheur Lakes Basin.	31,765	
Outreach and Education Funding to provide information to landowners, community leaders, and other decision-makers to increase their awareness of the CCAA (Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances) for sage-grouse.	39,700	
Restoration Twenty-six grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include grazing management improvements, removing noxious and invasive plants, managing western juniper, creating irrigation efficiencies or developing off-stream watering sites, installing livestock exclusion fencing, rehabilitating riparian and wetland areas, and improving upland habitat. For example, noxious weed and juniper removal on over 6,000 acres will limit Medusahead Rye infestations, improve wildlife forage, and enhance sage-grouse habitat.	768,160	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical assistance to create a database of existing well-log data in order to develop a groundwater model for the Harney Lakes Basin, as well as develop a programmatic CCAA for sage-grouse on private lands.	70,570
