Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	98,189	
Restoration Fourteen grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include removing noxious and invasive plants, creating irrigation efficiencies, and improving water quality. For example, piping an existing irrigation canal with a history of breaching not only conserves water, but prevents sediment-laden water from entering into Evans Creek, home to salmon, steelhead, and native trout.	333,125	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical assistance to conduct an instream flow analysis to allow the Middle Fork Irrigation District to model alternative flow regimes for developing operation and infrastructure improvements that can improve flow, water quality, instream habitat, and fish passage.	5,000
