Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board - OWEB		
Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Lake County Umbrella Watershed Council to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	416,426	
Restoration Thirty-one grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include creating irrigation efficiencies, reducing sediment and nutrients from entering streams, installing riparian exclusion fencing, developing off-stream watering sites, managing western juniper, removing noxious and invasive plants, and improving instream habitat and fish passage. For example, all remaining fish passage barriers on stream systems running through Sycan Marsh were removed. This now provides access to over 65 miles of new upstream habitat for Redband and Bull Trout and two endemic mussel species; and enhances habitat for Yellow Rails and Sandhill Cranes.	1,852,422	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical design assistance to design alternatives to existing irrigation diversion structures in Buck Creek that can allow passage of native Redband Trout and provide better water management.	10,500
