Acquisition Grants provided a portion of the funding needed to purchase a 400-acre property near Eugene that protects high-value prairie and oak savanna habitats and one of the largest known populations of the endangered Fender's Blue Butterfly and threatened Kincaid's Lupine.	752,231	
Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Coast Fork and Middle Fork Willamette Watershed Councils, McKenzie Watershed Council, and Siuslaw Watershed Council to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	274,914	
Monitoring Funds provided effectiveness monitoring to evaluate several wet prairie and wetland restoration projects and evaluate the effectiveness of treating areas infested by False Brome. Funds also supported a student water-quality monitoring program in the Siuslaw River Basin.	48,703	
Outreach and Education Provided funding for an outreach program intended to recruit landowners to engage in restoration projects in the Cedar Creek area. Additionally, funds were provided to support a variety of educational programs intended to increase student awareness and understanding of watershed function and health, as well as engage them in restoration or monitoring projects using a service-learning model and hands-on field experience. These programs include watershed exploration camps, the Stream Team Project, and the Watershed Rangers Project.	144,294	
Restoration Sixty grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include removing invasive plants, reducing sedimentation and nutrients that enter streams, installing riparian exclusion fencing, rehabilitating riparian and tidal wetland areas, improving instream habitat, removing fish passage barriers, and restoring wet prairie, oak savanna and woodland habitats. For example, over 15 fish passage barriers at stream crossings were removed in the Cleveland, Owens, and Ferguson Creek areas, opening up more than 50 miles of upstream habitat for fish.	3,409,005	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical assistance to design master restoration plans and complete engineering designs for floodplain-river connection for the Willamette Confluence Preserve, recruit landowners and develop associated restoration plans along Bear Creek, and complete a bio-survey and habitat assessment of Mosby Creek.	269,416
