Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Luckiamute Watershed Council and the Rickreall and Glenn-Gibson Watershed Councils to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	130,381	
Restoration Eleven grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include removing noxious and invasive plants, rehabilitating and restoring riparian and upland areas, and improving instream habitat. For example, a project to re-establish native plant communities in the Luckiamute State Natural Area, located at the confluence of the Luckiamute, Santiam, and Willamette Rivers, will provide improved forage and cover for birds and other wildlife and enhanced vegetation cover and diversity in frequently-inundated areas on the floodplain. Other benefits will develop over a longer timeframe as large trees established through the project contribute shade and wood to the rivers.	583,669	
Technical Assistance Funds provided landowners with technical assessment and design assistance in support of the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program.	34,290
