Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funding for the Sherman County Area Watershed Council to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	95,124	
Restoration Twenty-one grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include creating irrigation efficiencies, reducing sediment and nutrients from entering streams, installing riparian exclusion fencing, developing off-stream watering sites, removing noxious and invasive plants, and increasing direct seeding for crop production. For example, a project encompassing 4,000 acres will encourage wheat producers to transition from current farming practices to direct seed as a way to reduce erosion, improve soil health, and decrease sediment delivery to waterways.	210,076
