| <p>Restoration<br/>Sixteen grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include removing invasive plants, creating irrigation efficiencies, reducing sediment and nutrients from entering streams, developing off-stream watering sites, rehabilitating riparian areas, improving instream habitat, and removing fish passage barriers. For example, removing fish passage barriers on Birch Creek will open upstream habitat for native migratory fish including Steelhead and Redband Trout.</p> | 693,831          |                 |
