City of La Grande - Odd fellows/State Theater Buildings Cleanup Project The City of La Grande acquired the former Odd fellows/State Theatre property on April 2, 2012, pursuant to obtaining liability protection as a bona fide prospective purchaser through completion of a Revised Phase One Environmental Site Assessment completed to ASTM Standard #E1527-05 and US EPA's Federal Standard 40CFR Part 312 for "All Appropriate Inquiry." Acquisition of the Property was the number one funding priority for the City's Urban Renewal Advisory Commission in order to facilitate reclamation and transformation of a blighted property located in the core of its historic downtown district. On April 10, 2012, OBDD awarded the City of La Grande a \$200,000 Oregon Coalition Brownfields Cleanup Fund Grant (Q12003) for cleanup activities related to the redevelopment of the Property. Additional abatement of hazardous materials was required in certain portions of the buildings adding an additional \$34,125 in costs above the original project contract. The City of La Grande is seeking financing assistance through the Brownfields Redevelopment Fund to cover the additional unanticipated cleanup costs.	34,125

<b>Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board - OWEB</b>		
Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Grand Ronde Model Watershed Program to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	97,657	
Restoration Fifteen grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include removing invasive plants, creating irrigation efficiencies, developing off-stream watering sites, rehabilitating riparian areas, and improving instream habitat. For example, by returning the lower portion of Cusick Creek to its historic channel, severe erosion that deposits significant amounts of sediment into the Thief Valley Reservoir will be reduced and fish habitat will be improved.	439,129	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical assistance to conduct an analysis of the current infrastructure and inefficiencies in the Powder Valley Water Control District, create a drainage surface water management plan for Gekeler Slough, and create engineering designs to restore a portion of Medicine Creek to a meandering stream on the meadow surface.	83,694
