Monitoring Funds were provided to continue monitoring native Bull Trout on 42 miles of stream in the Grande Ronde and Imnaha River Basins, as well as monitor 275 acres on the Wallowa Moraine to determine current populations of Spalding's Catchfly.	41,568	
Outreach and Education Provided funding to support the Watershed Evaluation Team program, which targets students in Wallowa County to provide classroom and hands-on experience in data collection, watershed health, and increase awareness of watershed stewardship.	42,662	
Restoration Seventeen grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that removed noxious and invasive plants, improved water quality and quantity by creating irrigation efficiencies, prevented livestock from damaging riparian areas by installing exclusion fencing or developing off-stream watering sites, thinned overstocked forest stands to improve forest health, and made repairs to damaged fish screens on irrigation diversion structures. By replacing the open irrigation system on Farmers and Big Bend Ditches with piping, sediment and nutrients present in irrigation waste water will not enter Prairie Creek, and a more efficient delivery system will be used to irrigate over 1,300 acres.	814,216	
SWCD Funds provided outreach and technical assistance to local landowners. This includes: 1) promoting and implementing the Oregon Plan for Salmon and Watersheds; 2) improving landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and habitat for salmon; and 3) developing assessments and applying strategies to achieve the goals of the Oregon Plan.	57,138	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical assistance to conduct a baseline inventory and document for the Zumwalt Prairie conservation easement area.	5,680
