Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the John Day-Bridge Creek Watershed Council to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	89,330	
Monitoring Provided funding for effectiveness monitoring of infiltration galleries intended to collect excess irrigation water that pools in low-lying areas of agriculture fields and routes the excess flow into the wetland areas adjacent to Mountain Creek.	18,435	
Restoration Twenty-one grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include removing invasive plants, managing western juniper, creating irrigation efficiencies, developing off-stream watering sites, installing riparian exclusion fencing, rehabilitating riparian and upland areas, improving instream habitat, and removing fish passage barriers. For example, one project thinned 660 acres of overstocked and diseased stands of conifers to mitigate the threat of catastrophic wildfire and improve the hydrologic function of the forest uplands in the Mountain Creek watershed.	957,245
