Acquisition Funding was provided to assist in the purchase of 48 acres adjacent to its Yamhill Oaks Preserve in Gopher Valley, increasing the Yamhill Oaks Preserve to a total of 320 acres. This acquisition will protect oak woodland and savanna, upland prairie, and wet prairie to benefit species such as Acorn Woodpecker, Western Gray Squirrel, Fender's Blue Butterfly, Northern Red-legged Frog, Bradshaw's Lomatium, and Kincaid's Lupine.	110,038	
Local Capacity-Watershed Councils and SWCD Funds provided to the Greater Yamhill Watershed Council to support community efforts to protect and enhance clean water and healthy habitats for fish and wildlife. Funds provided to local Soil and Water Conservation Districts support implementation of Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plans. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance intended to improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and salmon habitat.	89,330

Restoration Nine grants provided funding for restoration projects that removed invasive plants and rehabilitated riparian areas; installed roof water catchment systems; installed systems to prevent sediment, nutrients, and stormwater runoff from entering directly into streams; provided appropriate habitat for the Fender's Blue Butterfly. One project removed a concrete access road and an associated undersized culvert on a tributary to the North Yamhill River, helping to improve summer flows, reduce channel erosion and sediment levels, and allow fish access to approximately seven miles of upstream habitat.	121,108	
Technical Assistance Grants provided funding to complete a basin-wide restoration action plan and provide landowners with technical assessment and design assistance in support of the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program.	126,256
