Local Capacity-SWCD Funds provided to one Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) to implement the Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plan to the fullest extent practical. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance to local landowners to: 1) promote and implement the Oregon Plan for Salmon and Watersheds; 2) improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and habitat for salmon; and 3) develop assessments and apply strategies to achieve the goals of the Oregon Plan.	141,860	
Monitoring Funds provided to continue: operation at four stream gages and three weather stations; a long-term monitoring study that examines coho salmon survival, life histories and habitat use in tidedegated lowland streams; and a monitoring program tracking 13 monitoring parameters.	173,362	
Outreach Funding provided for the Master Watershed Stewards program to improve knowledge of watershed function and foster active stewardship of natural resources. This program provides hands-on science labs, interactions with natural resource professionals, career exploration, and stewardship service. Participants will be directly engaged in restoration projects.	74,064	
Restoration Twenty grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include creating irrigation efficiencies; improving water quality; addressing noxious and invasive plants; and improving riparian and instream habitat and fish passage. For example, the China Camp Creek Project removed an old tidegate infrastructure and replaced it with an improved structure on the Coquille River.	1,120,511	
Technical Assistance Funds provided to identify fish passage barriers or impediments; conduct Aquatic Habitat Inventory surveys; and complete restoration designs, permits, and funding proposals.	184,837
