Local Capacity-SWCD Funds provided to one Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) to implement the Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plan to the fullest extent practical. This project includes providing outreach and technical assistance to local landowners to: 1) promote and implement the Oregon Plan for Salmon and Watersheds; 2) improve landowner involvement in conservation activities that enhance water quality and habitat for salmon; and 3) develop assessments and apply strategies to achieve the goals of the Oregon Plan.	141,860	
Outreach Funding continued to provide local students access to outdoor field activities that are part of the Crook County Career Technical Education-Natural Resources Program. Students are taught watershed and restoration science and engage directly in restoration activities.	48,836	
Restoration Twenty-one grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include managing western juniper; restoring sagebrush-steppe, dry pine, and forest-sagebrush; addressing noxious and invasive plants; developing off-stream watering sites; and improving irrigation efficiencies, riparian areas, floodplain connectivity, instream habitat and fish passage. For example, in the Upper Crooked River, a large project continued to address a multitude of resource issues including eroded stream banks, headcutting of streams, noxious weeds, juniper invasion, overstocked woodlands, sedimentation in streams, disconnected floodplains and loss of wet meadow complexes.	1,114,928	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical assessment, design and permitting assistance in support of the Curry Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program; support for cataloguing and prioritizing restoration opportunities; and funds for development of a Watershed Action Plan for the Lower Rogue.	233,732


