

Restoration Twelve grants provided funding for restoration projects including those that created irrigation efficiencies; managed western juniper; and improved water quality, instream, and riparian habitat. For example, several phases of a large project continued to pipe irrigation canals to improve water quality and instream habitat.	946,436	
Technical Assistance Funds provided technical engineering, design, and assessment assistance for projects to construct fish passage at Opal Springs Dam on the Lower Crooked River; assessed the feasibility of making irrigation delivery changes on Agency Plains; and provided landowners with assessment and design assistance in support of the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program.	112,268
