Outreach Provided funding to support programs engaging students and adults in hands-on learning about hydrological and ecological systems and why healthy streams and adjoining riparian and upland zones are critical to salmon and steelhead habitat.	93,920	
Restoration Eleven grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include addressing invasive plants; creating irrigation efficiencies; and improving water quality, riparian and floodplain habitat, and fish passage. For example, as part of a phased project, work is ongoing in preparation for removing Dillon Dam.	935,106	
Technical Assistance Funds provided: technical assistance to develop 100% designs for implementation of the irrigation conveyance alternative identified in the Dillon Dam Feasibility Study; for an assessment of hydrologic and geomorphic processes and identification of alternative solutions to restore natural channel and floodplain form and morphology, restore floodplain connectivity and improve flood attenuation through a range of high flow events; for designs for a habitat improvement project that will create better instream habitat, improve the riparian area, create meanders and side channels and improve bank stability; to evaluate the feasibility of removing or modifying a fish passage barrier; for conducting the public involvement process associated with preparation of the Birch Creek Assessment & Action Plan; and to convene a series of community meetings, identify a program of research and monitoring to locate the source of the problematic sediment build-up in Camas Creek, and work toward design solutions for the multi-faceted problem.	239,932


