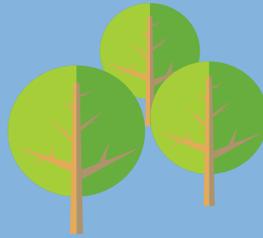

Restoration Thirteen grants provided funding for a variety of restoration projects that include addressing invasive plants; developing off-stream watering sites; installing riparian exclusion fencing and windbreaks; and improving water quality, upland, and riparian habitat. For example, a project associated with the City of LaGrande's domestic water storage facilities improved fish passage and late-season flows on Beaver Creek.	392,981
