

Restoration Eight grants provided funding for restoration projects that addressed invasive plants; improved riparian, upland, and wildlife habitat; and prevented sediment, nutrients, and stormwater runoff from entering directly into streams. One project restored 57 acres of oak savanna and oak woodland habitat by removing woody vegetation, treating invasive plant species, and planting native grasses and plants to restore oak savanna and woodland habitat structure.	165,546
